Directions to Club

The Club is located at 9020 S. Hwy 97, Redmond, OR 97756. From Redmond, the entrance is 4.0 miles south of the Yew Ave/Hwy 97 interchange in Redmond. From Bend, the entrance is 2.6 miles north of the Tumalo Rd/Deschutes Market Road over pass. The entrance is on the east side of Hwy 97 and is marked with a "sandwich board" sign and tall red flags. Follow the gravel road around the solar panels, turn left onto the red cinder covered road going east and cross the railroad tracks. There are signs to follow from here on in.

Please note, current Oregon Revised Statutes DO NOT allow for a left hand turn off the highway or onto the highway at that point. Shooters are strongly advised to make right hand turns only when entering or exiting the property. Depending on your direction of approach, consider going south to Tumalo Road/Deschutes Market Road, make the circle and come back north to the property entrance. When leaving, if you are going to Bend, it is advised that you go north to Yew Ave, make the loop and then head back south.
