

The Redmond Rod & Gun Club has an opening for a Director of the Rifle Pistol Ranges. This is a volunteer, elected position on the Board of Directors, with a 2 year term There are 9 months left in the current term to be filled by Board appointment.

The Club Bylaws outlines the responsibilities of the Director as:

(e) The Pistol & Rifle Director shall oversee the pistol and rifle ranges and shooting activities. Shall report all activities of the pistol & rifle ranges to the Executive Board at its regular meetings and at such other meetings of the Board of Directors and the members as may be requested, shall deposit with the Treasurer of the Club all funds generated from the pistol & rifle ranges, and shall perform such other duties as the Board may direct. The Rifle & Pistol Director must possess a current NRA certified Range Safety Officer (RSO) rating.

The Board will give preference to an applicant with positive communication and leadership skills, capable of leading a team of volunteers to generate new growth and expansion of the current ranges. Some of the 2021 goals are:

- 1) Promote enhanced and friendlier service to the range customers
- 2) Increase guidance and direction for RSOs
- 3) Provide leadership with current volunteers to ensure smooth daily operations
- 4) Partner with the Marketing Director
 - a. To develop short and long range plans for range development and marketing
 - b. Organize and lead a committee to solicit donations for construction of a new 200 yard range to be constructed beside the current 100 yard range
 - c. Create realistic goals for fundraising and milestones reported to the Board of Directors at each Board meeting
- 5) Coordinate with the Facility Director to obtain competitive bids for the range construction and help to oversee the construction
- 6) Willingness to support board visions and locate resources to accomplish such visions.
